## WHAT IS THE ROADS SCHOLAR PROGRAM?

Nevada T<sup>2</sup> Center's Roads Scholar Program is designed for local agency personnel who are committed to learning new skills and expanding their knowledge in the latest road and safety innovations and best practices. The Roads Scholar Program was created in 1994 to recognize those who complete prescribed Nevada Transportation Technology Transfer Center Workshops. The Nevada T<sup>2</sup> Center's Roads Scholar Program combines that training into a structured curriculum of half-day and full-day training sessions.

## ROADS SCHOLAR COURSES

To enroll in the Roads Scholar Program, you must submit an application form. The program requires you to complete 10 designated workshops during a six-year period. They consist of four required classes and six elective classes. A list of the current workshops is provided. Upon completing the requirements you will receive a Roads Scholar certificate and your supervisor will be notified in writing about your achievement.

Only training activities conducted by the Nevada T<sup>2</sup> Center that satisfy the required subjects, topics and training hours will be considered credit for this program. The program is designed to make you more knowledgeable and increase your likelihood of receiving a promotion.



## OTHER QUESTIONS

*When do I receive my certificate and other recognition?*

When your final course is completed, the Nevada T<sup>2</sup> Center will send a letter of confirmation to you. Award recognition is held at the last class you attend. A letter will be sent to your supervisor and your picture will appear in one issue of *Milepost* along with an article about you.

*What if I decide to not continue the program?*

You are under no obligation to complete the program, and you may resume your training any time. Upon re-enrollment, credit for your previously completed required courses will be counted toward another six-year term.

*May I attend workshops if I am not enrolled in the program?*

Absolutely! We encourage everyone interested in learning new skills and gaining valuable knowledge in road construction and maintenance to attend as many Nevada T<sup>2</sup> Center workshops as they wish.
