Roads Scholar Program

Enrollment in the Roads Scholar Program has grown rapidly since its inception in 1994. To become a Roads Scholar, you need to attend 10 designated one-day workshops during a six-year period. Upon completion of the Roads Scholar program, the Nevada T² Center gives you a certificate of completion and notifies your supervisor in writing of your achievement.

Training Workshops
